

7th - 12th Grade Art Supply List

Required supplies for 7th - 12th Grade Art Classes:

9" x 12" Sketchbook (approximately this size)

2 – Black Ultra Fine Sharpies

1 – Scissors (any type)

1 – Plastic Box (or shoe box) to store supplies – I strongly recommend a storage container of some type to secure items and to keep storage areas organized.

1 - Tacky Glue (small bottle - 4 oz)

Additional supplies for 8th - 12th Grade Art Classes:

2 – No. 2 Pencils or 2B Drawing Pencils (prefer no Eversharps/mechanical pencils)

1 - Vinyl Eraser

1 – Paint Palette with Plastic Cover – prefer a 7" round 10-well palette with lid (Please buy this from Mrs. Campbell if you can't find one with a lid. A lid will save your paint from drying out.)

1 – 4 oz Rubber Cement (plastic container – no glass jars)

Additional supplies for all High School Art Classes:

Assortment of sizes of cheap acrylic brushes

Additional supplies for Art Appreciation Class:

1 - 2" 3-ring binder - (approximately this size)

Markers and Colored Pencils:

You may use the classroom's markers and colored pencils or buy your own. I suggest a name brand such as Crayola or Prang for a more intense color.

*Please don't buy all new supplies if you already have it at home. There is no need to buy an expensive sketchbook (bring one from a previous class).

*If you are having a hard time finding the following supplies I have them for sale in the art room at a low price: 4 oz rubber cement - \$1.50 each, 2B drawing pencils - .75¢ each, vinyl erasers - .50¢ each, Ultra Fine Sharpies - \$1.00 each, and paint palettes with covers - \$2.00 per set.

*You may be asked to bring additional items from home throughout the school year.

*High School Art Classes: if there is any painting done with acrylics, you will be required to buy your own paint brushes. I will have them for sale in the art room approximately .75¢ to \$1.00 per brush or you may purchase your own.

*Please have all items labeled with name. HHS &/or the instructor is not responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen items.
