

7th - 12th Grade Art Supply List

Required supplies:

- 9" x 12" Sketchbook (approximately this size)
- 1 – 4 oz Rubber Cement (plastic container – no glass jars)
- 2 – No. 2 Pencils or 2B Drawing Pencils (prefer no Eversharps/mechanical pencils)
- 1 – Gum or White Vinyl Eraser,
or Kneaded Eraser (**High School Art Students Only**)
- 2 – Black Ultra Fine Sharpies
- 1 – Scissors (any type)
- 1 – Paint Palette with Plastic Cover – suggest a 7" round 10-well palette with lid
- 1 – Plastic Box (or shoe box) to store supplies – I strongly recommend a storage container of some type to secure items.
- 1 - Tacky Glue (4 or 8 oz)
- 1 - 1" 3-ring binder for **Middle School Art Students Only**
- 1 – Clear Packing Tape (approximately 2" W) for **High School Art Students Only**
- Assortment of sizes of acrylic brushes - **High School Art Students Only**

*Please don't buy all new supplies if you already have it at home. There is no need to buy an expensive sketchbook (bring one from a previous class).

*If you are having a hard time finding the following supplies I have them for sale in the art room at a low price: 4 oz rubber cement - \$1.50 each, 2B drawing pencils - .75 each, kneaded erasers - .75 each, gum erasers - .50 each, Ultra Fine Sharpies - \$1.00 each, and paint palettes with covers - \$2.00 per set.

*You may be asked to bring additional items from home throughout the school year.

*If there is any painting done with acrylics, you will be required to buy your own paint brushes. I will have them for sale in the art room approximately .75¢ to \$1.00 per brush or you may purchase your own.

*Please have all items labeled with name. HHS &/or the instructor is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Optional supplies:

Markers, Colored Pencils, and 8-Color Watercolor Paint Set:

I will supply the above, but if you wish to purchase your own that is fine. I suggest a name brand such as Crayola or Prang for a more intense color. I also recommend to all students a 3-ring notebook and a plastic box (or shoe box) to keep yourself organize and to keep your storage area in order. Thank you - Mrs.
